*Please note that we do not post the actual address of Nick's Place on our web site for confidentiality purposes, but all interviews will be conducted at the house address. Interviews usually last approximately 1 ½ hours. Please ask the transportation provider to call one of the phone numbers listed above if they are going to arrive more than 15 minutes before schedule or more than 15 minutes late.

Age Requirement:

Single, male 20-26 years of age

Minimum Length of Treatment:

21 days

Length of Stay:

Nick's Place asks for a six month minimum commitment, one year to complete our program. Nick's Place has 4 phases. Each phase is about 3 months. Resident will receive additional privileges as he accomplishes goals associated with each phase.

Interview Schedule:

We require an in person interview. These are generally scheduled Monday - Friday 11:00am - 3:00pm.

Program Fee:

(Includes room and board, life management and all of our Relapse Prevention Education Programs)

- \$525.00 at time of entry covers first three weeks of program fee – **this fee is non-refundable** (*this allows residents time to secure employment and receive their first paycheck.*)
- \$175.00 / per week, following week three

Intake Days and Requirements:

We typically receive residents Monday - Wednesday 11:00am - 3:00pm. Our requirement is for a resident to come bed-to-bed; **without returning home for any reason**. All residents will be given a drug screen upon entry.

Waiting List:

We do not place candidates on a waiting list.

Place Holding:

If the schedule allows, we will hold a bed for 1-2 weeks. **In this case, a non-refundable program holding fee of \$125.00 or \$250.00 will be charged. Both intake and holding fees can be made payable to Nick's Place and mailed to the address listed below.**

Proper Identification:

Whenever possible, residents should have a valid ID or Driver's License and an actual Social Security card for employment purposes. A birth certificate may be required for obtaining a Social Security card. This will facilitate the process when seeking employment.

Prescriptions:

Please ensure that residents have at least a 30-day prescription for any medication and if possible one refill. This will allow them adequate time to secure a health care provider. Residents must be stable on medication before coming to Nick's Place.

Other Medication:

We do not accept residents on Methadone or Suboxone.

Cash:

New residents should come with cash to carry them through while they seek employment. This cash will be secured in our safe.

Clothing:

Due to limited space, residents should bring clothing that is appropriate for the season. Additional clothing can be shipped or picked up on home visits. Please bring appropriate attire button down shirt, khakis or other semi-dress trousers for employment interviews.
